WITHIN TEN DAYS AFTER NOTIFYING ALL WATER CUSTOMERS OF THEIR LEAD SAMPLE RESULTS, SEND THE OFFICE OF DRINKING WATER A COPY OF:

- A. The notice distributed
- B. This form with the certification portion below completed

CERTIFICATION

I certify that (check all that apply):

- All customers served by the facility on a regular basis (e.g. employees, staff, students, etc.) received a notice of all lead tap water monitoring results either by postal mail, hand delivery, electronic mail, or conspicuous posting.
- All customers received the notice no later than 30 days after the water system learned of the lead tap monitoring results.
- The notice included the following information:
 - Result of lead tap water monitoring
 - Explanation of the health effects of lead using EPA mandatory language
 - List of steps consumers can take to reduce their exposure to lead in drinking water
 - The Maximum Contaminant Level Goal (MCLG) and the Action Level (AL) for lead and the EPA definitions
 - Utility contact information
